






## 2.1. Vocabulary. Travel items.

	<p><b>Ticket:</b> a small piece of paper or card given to someone, usually to show that they have paid for an event, journey, or activity.</p>
	<p><b>Passport:</b> an official document containing personal information and usually a photograph that allows a person to travel to foreign countries and to prove who they are.</p>
	<p><b>Luggage allowance:</b> the weight or number of cases and bags that you are allowed to take onto an aircraft without paying extra.</p>






**Sunglasses:** dark glasses that you wear to protect your eyes from bright light from the sun.



**Mobile phone:** a phone that is connected to the phone system by radio instead of by a wire, and can be used anywhere its signals can be received.



**Credit card:** a small plastic card that can be used as a method of payment, the money being taken from you at a later time.





**Suitcase:** a large, rectangular container with a handle, for carrying clothes and possessions while travelling



**Backpack:** a large bag used to carry things on your back, used especially by people who go camping or walking.

**Use:**

We use the present perfect to talk about how long something has existed or happened.

- We use since when we say the beginning of the period.

Example: Kelly has been on holiday since Monday

- We use for when we say the period of time

Example: I haven't seen Jenny for 2 weeks

## 2.8. Grammar. Events in the future: simple present and present continuous.

- We use the **simple present** to talk about events at a time later than now, based on present facts, time-table, schedule, calendar.

Example: The train arrives at 10.00 a. m. tomorrow.

- We use the **present continuous** to talk about plans or arrangements. We can use time expressions such as:
  - this afternoon / tonight
  - tomorrow morning / afternoon/ evening / night / the day after tomorrow
  - next week / month/ January / year.
  - in 2, 3, 4 etc... hours / days / weeks / months.
  - in 2034 (or other year)
  - on Christmas Eve / February 3rd
  - at the weekend

Example: Lucy is playing rugby tomorrow morning.
