Meaning:

We use the verb “**to wish**” + **past simple/continuous** to express that we don’t like a situation in the present (or future) and we want it to be different.

Examples:

- I **wish it wasn’t** raining = It is raining at the moment and I want it not to be raining.
- I **wish I was** rich = I am not rich but I want to be rich.
- I **wish John was** here = John is not here and I want him to be here.

Form:

Subject	+	wish	+	Subject + Past Tense



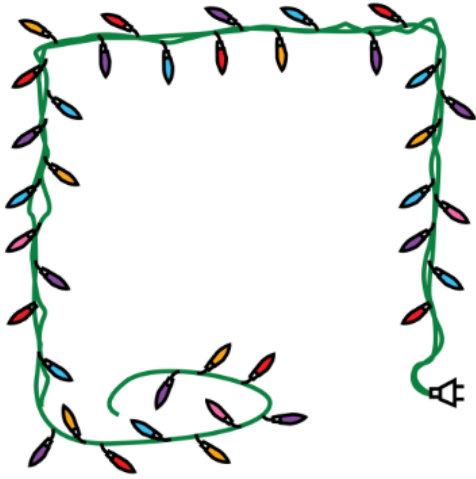
