shopping centre	everything

chemist's	medicines, beauty products
greengrocer's	fruit and vegetables
butcher's	meat
baker's	bread and pastry
florist's	flowers
newsagent's	newspapers, cigarettes, sweets, etc.

• We often use **noun** + **shop** for many shops: clothes shop, bookshop, shoe shop, music shop, etc.

6.6 Grammar. Indirect/polite questions.

Look at the two questions from the dialogues in exercises 6.4 and 6.5.:

- Could you tell me where the fitting rooms are?
- Do you know if I can get a refund?



*Remember:

- We use indirect questions when we want to be more polite or formal.
- Indirect questions start with a polite opening phrase (Could you tell me...,
 Do you know...)
- There is no question form after the question word or 'if'. The word order is the same as in a positive sentence:
 - > ... where the fitting rooms are (where + subject + verb).
 - ... if I can get a refund (if + subject + verb).

What's the word order in the emphasized parts of the sentences:

verb + subject or <u>subject + verb</u>?

These questions are called indirect questions. We use them when we want to be more polite or formal.

They start with polite opening phrases such as: Do you know.../ Could you tell me....

The word order after the question word or "if" is the same as in positive statements.





Compare:

- Where are the fitting rooms?(Direct question Where + verb + subject).
- Could you tell me where the fitting rooms are?
 (Indirect question Where + subject + verb).
- Can I get a refund?(Direct question verb + subject).
- Do you know if I can get a refund?
 (Indirect question if + subject + verb).
